The Marshall Plan provided millions of dollars of economic aid to countries crippled by WWII in an attempt to rebuild them and keep Soviet influence out of those countries.

NATO was a military alliance system between western European pro-democratic nations seeking to create a defensive alliance system capable of repelling Soviet advances and aggression.
